Dr. Jean-Marc Greneche is a CNRS research director at the Institut des Molécules et Matériaux du Mans (IMMM UMR CNRS 6283) at Le Mans University (France). He obtained a PhD in Physics in 1987. His scientific activities are related to magnetism, nanomagnetism and magnetic materials including crystalline, amorphous, nanoparticles and nanostructured solids, using ^{57}Fe Mössbauer spectrometry facilities. He collaborates with physicists, chemists, geologists and biologists and has established numerous international bilateral collaborations.

He had published more than 550 papers in international journals (indexed Scopus) with h-index = 55 and presented about 120 communications in symposia and national/international meetings.

He is Editor at Journal of Alloys and Compounds, Hyperfine Interactions and member of the International executive Board of the Applications of the Mössbauer Effect (IBAME).
