My research program currently focuses on several areas of plant physiology and environmental sciences, emphasizing on biomonitoring aquatic pollution by using algae and physico-chemical parameters and I am also working on the characterization of the physiological, biochemical and molecular mechanisms of tolerance to abiotic stresses such as drought and salinity. I published around 50 papers in indexed journals and several book chapters and non-indexed papers.
